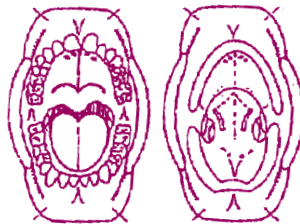

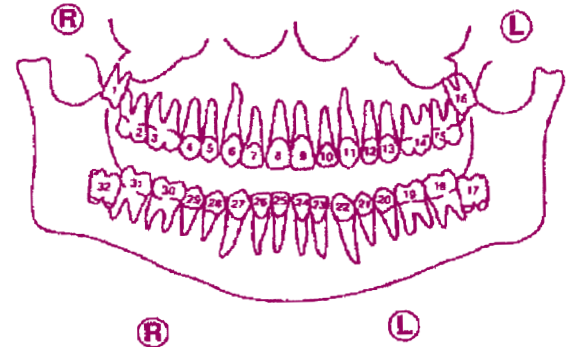

□ Instructions to Patients

You have been referred for specialized care to an Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon. Our office will make every effort to make your visit with us a comfortable experience. Please assist us by providing the following information at the time of your consultation.

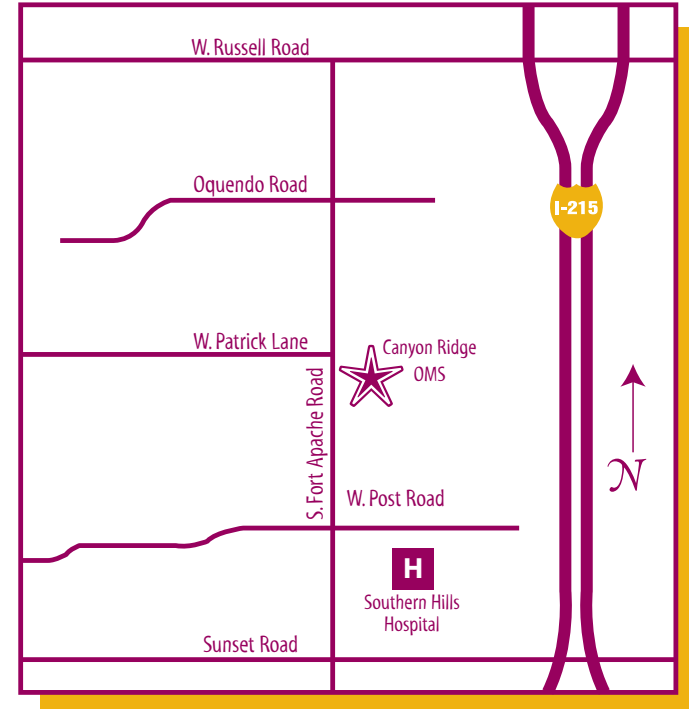
- This surgical referral slip and any x-rays, if applicable.
- A list of all medications you are presently taking.
- If you have medical or dental insurance, bring the necessary completed forms. This will save time and allow us to help you process any claims.

IMPORTANT: All patients under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the consultation visit.

- A pre-operative consultation and physical examination is mandatory for patients undergoing IV general anesthesia for surgery.
- Please alert the office if you have a medical condition that may be of concern prior to surgery (i.e. diabetes, high blood pressure, artificial heart valves and joints, rheumatic fever).
- Our office is determined to address any concerns you may have about your appointment. Please ask us so we may help you.

□ Special Instructions for General Anesthetic Patients

1. Do not take anything to eat or drink 6 hours prior to your surgery. It is extremely dangerous to have anything in your stomach during the anesthetic.
2. Please have a responsible adult accompany you on day of surgery and remain with you throughout the day. It is very important for them **to remain in the waiting room until you are ready to leave the office.** Most surgeries do not last more than one hour.
3. Any unmarried patient under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the time of the surgery.
4. Eat a light, easily digestible meal the night before the operation. Do not drink alcoholic beverages the night before.
5. Please wear loose, short sleeved clothing for accessibility to the upper arms so that we can place a blood pressure cuff. Sweatshirts are not advisable as they do not push up far enough.
